MANCHESTER — Local musician and recording artist Kelly Moore will sing The Star Spangled Banner when the Vermont Lake Monsters take on the Connecticut Tigers at Centennial Field in Burlington, Vermont on Friday June 24 at 7:05 p.m.

The Vermont Lake Monsters, the Burlington, Vermont minor league baseball team of Major

League Baseball's Oakland Athletics, and Music For Mankind® founder Kelly Moore, of Manchester Center, are teaming up to raise funds for the United Nations World Food Program and the Chittenden Emergency Food Shelf, a Burlington-based Feeding America food shelf.
